DAN CPR and First Aid (BLS)

Version 3.0 of DAN's BLS course includes 1- and 2-rescuer CPR, AEDs, and three methods for addressing Foreign Body Airway Obstructions (FBAO): abdominal thrusts, chest thrusts, and back blows for adults and children. The first aid section includes new information and skills pertaining to wound packing, dislocations, amputations, internal bleeding, open chest wounds, and spinal injury management.



Emergency Oxygen for Scuba Diving Injuries (EO2)


DAN's flagship first aid course, Emergency Oxygen for Scuba Diving Injuries teaches people how to administer lifesaving oxygen first aid to divers who may be suffering from decompression illness (DCI). This course features updated graphics, images, and videos in DAN's e-learning platform.



Diving First Aid for Professional Divers (DFA Pro)

This course, like past versions, incorporates all the knowledge, skills, and materials from BLS and EO2 and adds neurological assessment and first aid for hazardous marine life injuries. DFA Pro is designed for commercial, professional, aquarium, and scientific divers, and it provides knowledge and first aid skills specifically for these work environments. It is the most comprehensive first aid course in the dive industry.





FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the difference between Version 2.1 and Version 3.0? DAN's Version 3.0 first aid courses include both significant changes and small tweaks to make the training stronger and applicable to real-world rescue scenarios. Version 3.0 courses have updated videos in the e-learning platform and include updated graphics, images, and slates.

+ Why Version 3.0?

DAN updated its first aid training courses to meet recently updated ILCOR, AHA, and other guidelines for CPR and first aid skills.

+ What courses are being offered with Version 3.0?

DAN's Version 3.0 courses have been consolidated and simplified. They include DAN CPR and First Aid (BLS), Emergency Oxygen for Scuba Diving Injuries (EO2), and Diving First Aid for Professional Divers (DFA Pro). With the upgrade to Version 3.0, Neuro and HMLI courses are included only as part of DFA Pro, and DEMP has been discontinued.

+ Who can take these courses?

While all three Version 3.0 courses are diving-focused, or use diving in many of the examples and training scenarios, all courses are available to the general public, not just the diving community.

+ I just took a Version 2.1 course; is my certification still valid? Yes, Version 2.1 course certifications are valid for 2 years from the course completion date.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (Continued)

+ Are DEMP, Neuro, and HMLI included in Version 3.0? DEMP is being phased out. Neuro and HMLI are still included in Version 3.0 as part of DFA Pro but not as stand-alone courses.

What does a Version 2.1 DAN Instructor, IT, or Examiner need to do to upgrade to Version 3.0?

In most cases it is just a matter of taking the appropriate e-learning modules. These are available in the e-learning platform at **dan.diverelearning.com**. + What should I do if I can't find an Instructor Trainer or Examiner workshop in my area?

+ When will V2.1 be phased out?

We plan to phase out V2.1 training courses on June 30, 2022. This seven-month window was designed to give DAN Instructors enough time to complete the course requirements for a smooth transition to V3.0. Further information will be provided in upcoming editions of the Oxygen Window newsletter.

+ Can I still teach V2.1?

Yes you can while doing the transition from V2.1 to V3.0. However, effective June 30, 2022, all Version 2.1 courses must be completed and students approved.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (Continued)

+ What if I cannot complete the transition from V2.1 to V3.0 before the June 30, 2022 deadline?

Version 2.1 courses will be retired on July 1, 2022, and you will not be able to teach or approve students after this date. If you are unable to make the transition date, please contact DAN Training at oxygen@dan.org to discuss options.


